

TSCHA Youth Scholarship Program

Guidelines: Nite Hunt

Any Child 17 years of age and younger will be eligible for either of the two scholarships. Participation or the Interview Scholarship. A child that is 17 as of the State hunt held in September but turns 18 in that year will be able to still gather points toward the participation scholarship till the deadline of the next's State Hunt. The year will run from State Hunt in September to State Hunt of the following year. The two Scholarships will be in the amount of \$500.00 each. There will be two different winners, if you win the Participation scholarship you will not be eligible for the Interview scholarship. But please interview any way because the participation winner will not be decided till the end of the year. EVERY CHILD MUST TURN IN A COPY OF THEIR BIRTH CERTIFICATE TO VERIFY THEIR AGE!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

One(1) Participation point will be reward for each hunt the child enters to hunt in, regardless if they win a cast or not. If the cast is won another point will be reward to that child of the cast win. In any licensed event.

If the Child is a member of a club, that child will receive a participation point for every club that he or she is a member of. Copy of memberships card needs to be turn in at the same time as the participation form are turned in.

A child would receive two(2) points if they entered to hunt at any of the listed hunts; The two State hunts, American Heritage hunt, Invitational hunt, or the Cystic Fybrois Hunts, and both the Texas State Youth Hunts. You must have at least five (5) participation points to be eligible for the interview scholarship.

GUILD LINES BENCH SHOW:

Any Child 17 years of age and younger will be eligible for either of the two scholarships. Participation or the Interview Scholarship. Only one point will be give no matter how many dogs are show, the child will only receive one point even if the show one dog or five dogs. If a child wins class, breed best of show or overall, they will be given one additional point.

If the Child is a member of a club that child will receive a participation point for every club that he or she is a member of. Copy of memberships card needs to be turn in at the same time as the participation form are turned in.

A child would receive two(2) points if they entered to bench show at any of the listed hunts The two State hunts, American Heritage hunt, Invitational hunt, or the Cystic fybrois Hunts, and both the Texas State Youth Hunts. One (1) more points will be received if they win any of the following class, breed, best of show, or overall. You must have at least five (5) participation points to be eligible for the Interview scholarship.

We will also have an Interview process this year. The Scholarship will be broken up into two parts a participation scholarship and interview scholarships. The interview will be conducted by a panel of Texas State Broad Members and will be conducted at both Texas State Youth Hunts. It will be question and answer type interview you must have at least five (5) Participation points to be eligible for the interview scholarship.

Scholarship will be held in escrow by the Treasurer of the Texas State Coonhunter Association. It will be available for your use immediately following your graduation from high School and for a period of one (1) year after. You may redeem the Scholarship by notifying the TSCHA broad of Directors of your graduation date, The name and address of the high school you will graduate and providing the name and address of the accredited college, University or Trade School that you will attend to which the Scholarship will be paid of your behalf
